### **Trinity Lutheran School**

#### Statement of Faith

As a school owned and operated by Trinity Lutheran Church, a member congregation of the Lutheran Church—Missouri Synod, we hold the unanimous position of the universal Christian Church that:

- 1) the Bible (Old & New Testaments) are the inspired, infallible, and inerrant word of God.
- 2) God's word was written to make us wise unto salvation by teaching us to know him as the one, true God.
- 3) the one true God is three Persons in one Essence, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit (the Holy Trinity), co-equal, co-eternal, etc.
- 4) the Son of God was made true man in time, lived a holy and righteous life under God's law in our place, gave his life into death on the cross to atone for the sins of all people, rose again the third day, ascended to the right hand of the Father, sent his Holy Spirit to work faith in our hearts through the word of God and to enlighten those who believe, and that he will come again to judge all people on the last day.
- 5) that all people are conceived and born sinful and under the curse of God's righteous judgment, without true fear, love, or trust toward God, and in need of divine mercy.
- 6) that without the Holy Spirit working through the word no one can come to faith.
- 7) that, through the truth of the gospel which Jesus commanded to be preached in his name, and by the sacraments (Baptism and the Lord's Supper), which Jesus instituted for his Church on earth, God works faith in Christ in all who believe,
- 8) and in this way he creates his Church and cares for all Christians whom he continually comforts and strengthens through the gospel.
- 9) The gospel is the good news of salvation for all people since Jesus suffered and died for all people.
- 10) The Bible is the sole rule and norm of all that we believe, because it is the sole rule and norm of all that God teaches.
- 11) Through the law, God shows us our sin, convicts us, and leads us to repentance.
- 12) Through the gospel, God shows us our Savior, converts us, and keeps us in the faith.
- 13) Jesus, who is fully God and fully Man, commands us to hear his word often, to grow thereby in faith and confidence in his grace, and to willingly live a holy life both to his glory and to the service of our neighbor according to the 10 Commandments, all in the confidence of his forgiveness and in hope of the promise of the resurrection of the dead and the eternal life of the world to come.
- 14) God still makes us either male and female and restricts all sexual activity to marriage where he desires to bless husband and wife with children.
- 15) The duty of raising children in the faith and in all useful and honorable arts and knowledge belongs primarily to the parents who are responsible for teaching them (and finding, evaluating, and supporting those who teach for them). Those who assist in this responsibility perform a loving service and are both answerable to God and worthy of honor.
